Huckleberry's mission is to educate, inspire, and support under served youth to develop healthy life choices, to maximize their potential, and to realize their dreams. The Community Assessment & Referral Center (CARC) is a Case Management program initially designed to assist youth who have been arrested in the County of San Francisco, in recent years we have opened up our criteria for participants to include youth who are not involved in the Juvenile Justice System. The youth we serve are ages 11-17.

Time Commitment

- 9 month commitment (November –July)
- Organize 1 outing a week with your mentee that will help them achieve the agreed upon goals
- Weekly e-mail updating on match status
- Attend monthly mentor workshops at CARC the first Wednesday of every month from 6:30pm 8:30 pm
- Attend group outings (2 out of 3 required)

Additional Info

- All pairs must use public transportation unless mentor has been approved to drive by Huckleberry HR
- Mentors will receive reimbursements of up to \$30/month for activities with your mentee.
